- **c. CAA:** Esplanade House: families gaining housing, open up vacancies and now there is a waiting list. (3 months out to get in)
- d. **CUSD**: Added After school programs at a few schools. Quarterly feedback meetings at CUSD. <u>P-EBT</u>, Free Internet programs <u>Project 10 Million</u> and <u>Internet Essentials</u>, Open TCM position.
- e. Catalyst: Cottage open 2 bedroom 1 bath, Open job vacancy.
- f. **DESS**: HH-H-DAPT: Help with deposit, focus on families with disabilities.
- g. **OCESD**: Transportation issues, Open positions, intern starting in January.
- h. BCCS -New position added
- i. <u>BGCNV</u>, returning families who went MIA over Covid, Using Once Upon a Child for clothing support, shared positive feedback on CARE Team, suicide prevention focus, CARE team is recruiting more coaches. ILP store
- j. **BCOE**: Identifying and training staff. Tutoring is up and running. <u>Shared article about rural homelessness through Schoolhouse Connection</u>. Countywide transportation committee starting up.
