#### Summary of Project and Expected Outcomes:

This is a three-year project to transition Oroville Rescue Mission to a low-barrier overnight homeless emergency shelter and to increase capacity by adding three positions: a case manager, a intake/navigator and an overnight shelter supervisor all trained in best practices to assist persons experiencing homelessness and those at risk of homelessness to access permanent affordable housing and necessary support services in a client-centered approach.

#### The outcomes will be:

- 1) The Mission will assist 300 to 400 people in obtaining supportive services.
- 2) The Mission will provide up to 87,600 shelter nights serving up to 80 people per night in the facility with the goal of inputting all into the HMIS coordinated entry system.
- 3) The Mission's goal is to assist 50 people experiencing homelessness in permanent housing.
- 4) The Mission will be able to quantify its services and track its progress on successful outcomes.

#### **Summary of Project and Expected Outcomes:**

We have seen an increase in the needs of the participants with whom we have been working. In the last few years we have experienced a trend of more people who identify as chronically homeless coming into our shelter. As such we need more advocacy hours and more supportive services. In fiscal year 2017-2018 we were unable to offer services to over 280 families who reached out to us for help.

This project seeks to hire and additional .9 FTE Advocate and .5 FTE Counselor for services at Catalyst's Emergency Shelter, HAVEN. This would allow us to increase our capacity to serve three (3) more families on an ongoing basis at HAVEN. Based upon historical data and proposed length of time we anticipate this assisting an additional 12-20 families first in providing emergency safe housing then working with these same families to find more permanent housing solutions either through our programs or with our partners in the community.
