Funding and Priorities for this Super NOFA

The BCHCoC seeks to maximize use of the available funds to meet local priorities. Funding under this Super NOFA may include funds from the following sources;

ESG RRH	\$ 121,325.00	April 1, 2020 – March 30, 2021	Any eligible activities related to Rapid Re-housing. Expansion of existing RRH, establishment of new RRH, funding RRH that has operated successfully and will be expiring. The BCHCoC may recommend two proposals for funding. Up to 10% of the funds can be used in each category for street outreach, homelessness prevention, and HMIS.
ESG Competitive	\$ 400,000.00	April 1, 2020 – March 30, 2021	Any eligible activities related to Emergency Shelter including but not limited to capital , operating and/or service supports. This is one-year funding only. <u>The BCHCoC may submit two proposals to the Northern region's competitive pool. THERE is a \$75,000 min grant amount and a \$200,000 maximum grant amount.</u>
CESH Round 1	\$ 401,060.00	August 1, 2019 – July 30, 2023	CESH funds may be requested for capital , operating and/or services supports for emergency shelters. CESH funds can be expended over a five-year period. The BCHCoC reserves the right to award planning grants in combination with conditional shelter awards in order to bring an applicant into compliance with state requirements. All capital, operating and/or support funds would be utilized starting at the end of the planning grant period.
CESH Round 2	\$ 226,060.00	August 1, 2020 – July 30, 2024	CESH funds may be requested for capital , operating and/or services supports for emergency shelters. CESH funds can be expended over a five-year period.
HEAP Funds	\$ 450,000.00	August 1, 2019 – May 31, 2021	HEAP funds may be requested for capital, operating and/or services supports for emergency shelters.

A1: No More than 5 per year, which would equal 15 total

Q4: Tab C #5... Please clarify the definition of Business Partner or Associate?

A4: This refers to an organization that your organization has had a contractual or business relationship with, or has an active MOU within the last 5 years.

Q5: Tab F #1... References. What we are asked to provide implies that we have had a contract with that agency. For example, we would provide Youth For Change (assuming they are not applying but just as an example) as a reference however we have not had any contract with them and would not be able to include Project Name, Dates work performed; summary of scope of work, project costs. We would have to include our state or city contacts for that kind of thing

A4: See Change in Reference - This reference would be someone who could speak about your ability as a homeless provider and how the project you are looking to be funded is similar to an activity your organization has done before.

Q6: I want to confirm that CESH 2 starts August 2020. I also want to confirm that both CESH 1 and 2 are five full years. It is unclear in the funding table on page 5.

A6: We are only able to provide information that HCD/CESH is providing. In the CESH amended NOFA released by HCD, page 6, section 6, states 5 years. Although we have been awarded CESH 1, but do not have a contract with the State HCD, it is our best estimate that this CESH 2 funding will be in contract and available funding will start in August 2020. Given the state's delays in contracts, we expect the funding for CESH to be used up by 2024.

Q7: I have a question regarding the grant. On the Government exclusion list. Looking into the SAM only shows that nothing is found for us. Is there a waiver that can be done for us?

A7: If you do not have a SAM registration, please state that in your response. If you awarded a grant, you will need to acquire a SAM number prior to any grant disbursements. Not having a SAM number at this time is not a disqualification, unless you are funded solely for ESG, as it is a requirement from them.
