



CoC Membership Recommend Awards from the Fy2019 Super NOFA

Approved at CoC All Membership Meeting on July 15, 2019

Approval of \$272,875 from HEAP and CESH 1 funding to the **Oroville Rescue Mission** for supportive Services for Shelter Operations.

- i. This amount Includes : Requested \$267,875
 - a. Planning Grant \$5,000 to assist with capacity & process changes

Approval of \$207,000 from CESH 1 funding to the **Catalyst Domestic Violence Shelter** for Supportive Services for Shelter Operations.

Approval of \$226,060 from CESH 2 funding to the **True North Housing Alliance Inc,** for Shelter Operations for the Torres Shelter.

Approval of \$45,000 from HEAP funding to the **Oroville Rescue Mission** for Food Storage and Other Capital Purchases to Support Emergency Shelter Operations.

- ii. This amount Includes : Requested \$42,879 for Unit Operating Costs for Unit May 2021 \$2,121

Approval of \$189,877 from HEAP funding to the **True North Housing Alliance Inc,** for Sub-Contracting with Safe Space Winter Shelter, conditioned upon:
