SUBJECT: Homeless Housing Incentive Program Review and Ranking

The Housing and Homelessness Incentive Program (HHIP) supports delivery and coordination of health and housing services for Medi-Cal members by rewarding Managed Care Plans (MCP) for developing the necessary capacity and partnerships to connect their members to needed housing services and incentivizing MCPs to take an active role in reducing and preventing homelessness.

As the local MCPs, Anthem Blue Cross and California Health and Wellness are making investments in Increased Street Outreach Services, Flexible Financial Assistance for Housing Lease Up, and Enhanced Housing Navigation/Services in Shelter. Through this investment process, the MCPs have made HHIP funds available to local service providers. Funds are tentatively to be distributed as follows:

- Increased Street Outreach Services - \$300,000
- Flexible Financial Assistance for Housing Lease Up - \$400,000
- Enhanced Housing Navigation/Services in Shelter - \$500,000

Awards for HHIP funds are made based on recommendations from the CoC, however, final decisions will be made by MCPs. Recommendations from the CoC will be determined by a review and ranking committee as outlined in the proposed Review and Ranking Policy and Procedures. This memo serves to provide notice of who will be on the Review and Ranking Committee.
